Hi Family,

I hope everyone had a great Thanksgiving with family and friends. I would like to express my apologies for not preparing and sending a report to be read on the area conference floor last month. I appreciate your patience and understanding while I was in Chicago dealing with family matters. Here is the report from the region for October. It is as follows:

The Central Atlantic Region met on October 16, 2022 via Zoom. There were 10 areas in attendance. I've attached my report that was given to the region. There are some area events that might be of interest to our members in the region. Information can be found at: <https://car-na.org/calendar/>.

The treasurer reported that they met for the budget meeting on October 2nd AT 6PM via zoom. The proposed budget for the coming year has been returned to the secretary and was asked to be sent on for your review on October 4th. The updated proposed budget was sent to homegroups by Misty M. and due to some challenges getting out the budget in a timely manner with multiple changes I am asking for a vote of confidence from the groups in the event that we are able to vote on the conference floor at the upcoming regional conference.

RD reported Conference Participant Webinar on August 20, 2022 dealt with plans for the 2023 Conference Agenda Report and updates including the Iran Region decision. Three positions are posted for NA World Services. Staffing is still below pandemic levels, which was 46 and this will make 29. AZF next meeting will be on October 24, 2022, beginning 7pm. All positions are open, Treasurer, Facilitator and Secretary. Go to www.AutonomyZonalforum.org for resumes and job descriptions as well as deadlines to apply. The AZF agenda meeting was held on October 24th at 7pm via Zoom. The Delegate Team is working on a venue to host the January 28, 29, 2023 AZF and MALCNA will be held on January 20, 21, 22, 2023 in Lancaster, PA.

RDA reported that she was a delegate on the team to give collaboration of US Zones and also reports that on April 10, 2022 Craig, WG Facilitator, presented a 3-part Survey package :

- Survey Narrative
- PowerPoint video
- Survey

The delegate team had set up the survey for completion on our CARNA (central Atlantic) website. Surveys are listed at: <https://www.na.org/?ID=projects>. The survey that was closed for submissions on November 13th began with the following question:

- Does your region support the zones of the US forming a service body to collaborate?

The RDA also reported that there is a Collaboration of US zones task group and is requesting a response to the poll by December 13th. You may go to <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/R2BXGCN> to complete. The next meeting will be held January 8, 2023- 6:00 pm EST Hosted by Plain States Zone. The RDA reports that she attended the budget meeting and also the multizonal service symposium held on October 13-15th. She shared that the 2023 WSC will be held April 30th-May 6th of 2023. RDA2 Reported that due to family and business concerns he will be unable to attend the 2023 World Service Conference. He will be able to fulfill all other duties of the RDA2 position and, if elected RDA, will be able to attend future WSC. He asked the body for a straw poll to give him direction around continuing in the RDA2 position given his inability to attend WSC 2023.

Description: Normally the NA WSC will fund the regional delegates. Due to the pandemic reduction of

staff and literature sales world services is asking any region that can to fund their delegate to do so if possible.
